Accounting for Patient Movement Equipment Items (PMI) in Support of Critical Care Air Transport Team

Recently a decision was reached that PMI levels calculated to support the Aeromedical Evacuation patient flow included requirements for transporting patients under care by Critical Care Air Transport Teams (CCATT). This decision has created a challenge for logistics personnel to ensure property accountability and maintenance of these assets. To achieve PMI equipment accountability for assets stored in support of a CCATT:

- Store PMI equipment with CCATT
- Maintain PMI equipment on MEMO equipment records
 - RC/CC XX5881
 - Allowance Source Code SP11
- Equipment will be Bar Coded in a joint effort by AMC/SG and PMI Center personnel and Recorded in the Plexus database

For more information on the PMI Program and Plexus procedures visit URL <http://usafsg.satx.disa.mil/~amcsg/SGSL/pmi.htm>. The other logistics challenge is maintaining the equipment. To insure proper maintenance of PMI equipment assets stored in support of a CCATT:

- Custodians and Host MEMO officers are responsible for insuring PMI equipment is properly maintained
- When organic bio-medical maintenance support is available
 - Provide scheduled and unscheduled maintenance support

- Forward copy of completed Work Orders to regional PMI Center
- The regional PMI Center will update the Plexus database with current preventive maintenance information
- When there is no organic bio-medical maintenance support, scheduled and unscheduled maintenance will be accomplished by the regional PMI Center
 - Update the Work Order with Action Code "RD"
 - A shipping document will be prepared for shipment to the PMI Center
 - A copy of the Work Order will accompany the equipment so an annotated copy can be returned by the PMI Center to allow update of historical maintenance records
 - The shipping activity will maintain a copy of the shipment document as proof of shipment until equipment is received back from the regional PMI Center
 - The PMI Center will update the Plexus system upon receipt of the equipment
 - The Work Order that is shipped with the equipment will be completed by the PMI Center
 - A copy of the completed Work Order will be maintained by the PMI Center and a copy returned with the equipment
 - The PMI Center will update Plexus to reflect that repair or calibration was completed and the equipment was shipped back to the unit
 - Upon receipt of the equipment the unit will ensure historical maintenance records are updated using the Work Order from the PMI Center

These procedures will insure property accountability and maintenance for PMI equipment used in support of a CCATT mission. We must

overcome one more challenge. The first 19 CCATT packages assembled by AFMLO/FOC-I at Fort Worth, TX included the PMI equipment. Additional procedures are required to transfer accountability of this PMI equipment to MEMO. Procedures are as follows:

1. Go to **ESTABLISH/REVISE STOCK CONTROL LEVEL - SLR** menu. Process SLR transactions for the following NSNs to reduce WRM levels in CCATTs to zero.

2. If the CCATT is in detachment A, go to **INTERNAL TRANSFERS - ITT** menu and process ITTs to transfer these items to excess. If assets are in a different detachment, go to **GAINS/LOSSES - GLT** menu and process an SFL out-shipment to MDSF account, to drop items. Process an SFG in-shipment from MDSF account, into excess in detachment A.

3. Go to **ISSUE/TURN-IN - ITJ** menu and process non-reimbursable issues, PII from excess to RC/CC XX5881. Ensure the following codes are entered into the PII.

- a) Demand Code = N
- b) Equipment ID = M
- c) Refund Code = N

AFMLL Articles - *Medical Logistics In Action*

Medical Logistics In Action is one of the most popular areas of the AFMLL. Everyone likes to see their name and accomplishments in print, and we are more than happy to include these recognitions in the AFMLL. The following items are acceptable for inclusion in the AFMLL.

Recognition for *Airman, NCO, Senior NCO, Company Grade Officer, and Civilian of the Month, Quarter, or Year.* List the period and organization level of the award down to the squadron level. For instance, The 2000th Medical Group selected SrA John Doe as the Airman of the Quarter for the period 1 Jan - 31 March 1995.

Graduation from official courses with honors. This includes Professional Military Education courses. Because certain courses are mandatory, and most logisticians will graduate, only honor graduates will be printed.

Appointment to membership, affiliation, or certification in professional organizations. (AAMI/CBET/BMET/SOLE/ACHCE/CLINICAL ENGINEERING GROUP)

Official military medals and awards, except those common to all. Examples of common awards are the National Defense Medal or Good Conduct Medal.

Notices on retirements from the Air Force of Logistics personnel.

Graduation from the official 4A1X1 and 4A2X1 courses at Sheppard. The intermediate supervisors at the school at Sheppard AFB provide this information to AFMLO. Recognition of the Honor Graduate is indicated.

Military selection for promotion. AFMSA/SGSL and the Senior Enlisted Career Advisors provide this information to AFMLO.

Military promotions. Personnel may be recognized when promotions occur.

CDC End of Course examination score of over 90 percent. The Senior Enlisted Career Advisors have the option to determine a different percentage.

AFMLO will review other submissions on a case-by-case basis. These include: logistics related awards, Commanders awards, military citizenship awards, logistics related college degrees, and other miscellaneous information.

Allowance Standard (AS) Updates
