If an NSN is replaced and you have on-hand balances, a P&S relationship should be established. ## **Realignment of DFAS Operating Locations (OPLOCs)**

Due to closure of the Defense Finance and Accounting Service Denver Center (DFAS-DE) Operating Location (OPLOC) in July 2000, several medical accounts will be switched to another OPLOC. Those medical accounts currently being serviced by DFAS-DE OPLOC are Andrews, Bolling, Cannon, Davis-Monthan, Holloman, Kirtland and Luke. In addition, DFAS will realign all medical facilities based on MAJCOMs beginning June 2000. The complete realignment should take up to two years.
