### Contracting Corner

*Contracting Officer Representative (COR) Mentor Course*

Try the new web-based COR mentor course! The COR Mentor course provides self-paced learning for a total of 18 specific duties which may be assigned to a Contracting Officer Representative.

This course has approximately 45 seat-hours of courseware presented in a structured, certification path or through unstructured, ad hoc queries against the database of courseware. Students are presented with several modules covering elements for each COR duty. These modules include an executive summary, a procedure map that delineates the steps involved in performing various COR duties, a multimedia tutorial, library items including regulations, samples, questions and discussions, and electronic tools.

## Placeholder Numbers in the Universal Data Repository (UDR)

In the June issue of the UDR, the Service Assemblage Section will contain some "placeholder" numbers in the NSN field for the newly approved Allowance Standards. These placeholder numbers are assigned at AFMLO to identify an item that is pending NSN assignment. The general format of the placeholder number is 15 positions. The first four positions are the Federal Stock Class for the item; the next two are a standard "NC"; the next position is either "M" for a medical item or "D" for a non-medical item; the next 2 positions are the current calendar year, and the next 4 positions are a sequential serial number followed by a standard suffix of "MD". The current field for NSN in the UDR will only allow 13 positions; therefore the "MD" suffix on the placeholder number was dropped. We are working with the UDR programmers to change the UDR format to allow a 2-position suffix to an NSN or placeholder number. In the meantime, any number that meets the above format for a placeholder number can be researched in the UDR accurately by simply omitting the MD suffix. ## Information from the Logistics and Readiness Analysis Team

### *Did You Know?*

AFMLO/FOC-A still has a requirement for the end-of-month BMSO/BAFO. The most reliable way to transmit the BMSO/BAFO to AFMLO is by FTP (file transfer protocol). The FTP sends the file directly from the MEDLOG HP server at the base to the AFMLO file server eliminating problems such as illegible faxes, incorrect e-mail addresses and the old "I forgot to send it". **Attachment 1** is instructions on setting up the FTP process.

## Intermec RF Scanners

The Intermec RF scanners you have been storing for use with MEDLOG RF use two batteries as a power source. The external NiCad battery is housed in the handle of the scanner and can be removed for charging. An internal lithium backup battery cannot be removed for charging. This battery is continually charged by the external battery.

Due to lack of use, it is possible that the internal batteries in your RF scanners are either weak or totally discharged, which would render the scanners inoperable. To ensure that your two RF scanners are functioning properly, we are requesting that you check the status of the internal batteries. Complete the following processes:

- ◆ Charge the external batteries received with the RF scanners for a minimum of 24 hours. You can use the battery chargers for the SIFA scanners for this purpose. After charging, insert the batteries into the handle of the RF scanners.
- ◆ Ensure the scanners are powered off. Then, boot the scanners by simultaneously depressing the F3 key, left arrow key (on the diamond shaped pad), and number 2 key. After releasing these keys, press the 2 key, then the I/O key. At this point carefully observe the screen display that appears on the scanners.
- ◆ If the scanner does not power up or displays a message indicating the battery is weak or low, use the I/O key to power off the scanner. The battery is properly charged if no low battery message appears and the scanner eventually displays the boot loader menu.

If the battery is low, do the following:

- ◆ With an external battery housed in the handle, load the scanner in one of the docking stations used for the SIFA scanners.
- ◆ After charging for a minimum of 15 hours, repeat steps 2a through 2c above.

If the battery is still low, contact Intermec and arrange to have your scanners returned for replacement of the internal battery. Instructions for contacting Intermec are located on the MEDLOG WEB site under the news category.

Once both scanners have good internal batteries, you should place them in a storage mode. Do this as follows:

- ◆ Boot the scanner by simultaneously depressing the F3 key, left arrow key (on the diamond shaped pad), and number 2 key. After releasing these keys, press the number 2 key, then the I/O key.
- ◆ At the boot loader menu, use the down arrow key (on the diamond shaped pad) to highlight storage mode and press the enter key. The scanner will power off in a storage mode, which will ensure that the internal battery remains charged. At this point, you should remove the external battery from the scanner.

## **TRICARE Pharmaceutical Prime Vendor (PV) Contracts**

DSCP is currently aligning the Pharmaceutical PV Regions to coincide with TRICARE regions. So far, they have awarded new Pharmaceutical PV Contracts for DoD PV customers in TRICARE Regions 1, 2, 3 and 5. DSCP is also obtaining a backup alternate source of supply for the primary PV via the use of a secondary PV. A list of changes resulting from the award of these new contracts is summarized below:

- ◆ New pharmaceutical Distribution Fees which means lower prices.
- ◆ Philadelphia Region is now serviced by the Bindley Western Drug Co.
- ◆ Medical activities in North Carolina are being realigned from the North Carolina/South Carolina Region to the Virginia/Tidewater/North Carolina Region (Mid-Atlantic). South Carolina will continue to be supported by Bindley Western Drug Co. as their Prime Vendor for pharmaceutical items.
- ◆ Backup Pharmaceutical PVs are being awarded for each TRICARE Region. Secondary or back-up PVs are a manual interface, i.e. offline orders, with MEDLOG at this time.
- ◆ Period of Performance in contract will be 20 months instead of 12 months.

Over the next few months, DSCP will be awarding new TRICARE Pharmaceutical contracts for the remaining TRICARE regions. A summary of current Pharmaceutical PV Contracts by TRICARE region is shown below:
