Are You Experiencing WRM Shortages?

SrA Jones was just notified WRM funds for next year will be extremely limited. This is very frustrating since the materiel availability percentage for the ATC is at 65 percent. The ATC is a critical WRM assemblage needed during an upcoming exercise in about six months. SrA Jones was discussing with his supervisor, Sergeant Smith, the frustration she felt trying to get the ATC up to speed. How do they expect me to increase the readiness of our ATC without funds? Sergeant Smith quickly remedied the situation with the answer to the following question: *How can I easily find excess to fill shortages in my ATC?* AFMLO has provided a web query to do just that! From the AFMLO web site, select the Procurement Page link, <http://afml.ft-detrick.af.mil/afmlo/fom-p/fom-p.htm>. From the Procurement Page, select the Excess Page link and then select the 'Search Available Excess List' link. Next you will need to select 'Find Excess Matching an Allowance Standard' button. Highlight the 'ATC Allowance Standard' and 'Search'. The results will list, in NSN sequence, all excess materiel that can be used to fill shortages on your ATC. At the bottom of the page, select 'Download' to save the matches to a file for easy comparison to WRM shortages. SrA Jones was amazed just a few keystrokes could display many items needed to fill ATC shortages. Try this web tool, and many other web-tools, available for your account at the AFMLO web site. Allowance Standard (AS) Updates

Attachment 4 contains AS updates. Changes are the result of cataloging actions to replace Acquisition Advice Code “V” and “Y” NSNs and changes generated by the Offices of Primary Responsibility. These changes are provided to update your WRM records. Remember to establish prime-substitute (P&S) relationships when applicable. Use the information in the “Add” and “Replaced” portion of the change document to determine the need for P&S relationships. If an NSN is replaced and you have on-hand balances, a P&S relationship should be established. Adjust WRM levels on NSNs listed as “Add” or “Delete.” If you have any questions or concerns, contact the appropriate AS manager. The AS manager and the most current AS version can be found on the Air Force Medical Logistics Office (AFMLO) Home Page under the Medical Combat Support Operations Team option. All changes contained in this attachment are minor changes and no SORTS reporting option is required. Any major Allowance Standard changes generated will be identified and SORTS reporting option provided through the Transition Plan from MEFPK and SGXR. Shipment and Transfer Reporting Procedures

Medical Logistics is required to report all shipments and transfers to the Defense Reutilization and Marketing Office (DRMO) by transmitting AS3 shipment status through DAAS to the Defense Reutilization and Marketing Service (DRMS). AS3 shipping status is entered into MEDLOG using the AIT screen according to AFCSM 41-230, Sections 12 and 25 in the following format.

DRMS sends Disposal Shipment Confirmation follow-up through DAAS to Medical Logistics whenever a discrepancy exists between the AS3 status and items shipped or transferred to DRMO. DRMS in-transit control advice codes are provided in columns 65-66 of the status image and are listed below. Medical Logistics must research follow-ups and provide timely feedback to DRMS through DAAS using the AS3 transaction.

Advice Code

Definition

35 There is a quantity variance between the DRMS receipt quantity and the AS3 quantity.

36 A DRMO receipt exists for which a matching AS3 has not been received.

37 An AS3 has been received for which a matching DRMO receipt has not been received.

Activities receiving follow-ups for property previously transferred to DRMO and not reported via AS3 should validate the follow-ups using the signed DD Form 1348 and/or DD Form 1348-1A from the local DRMO within 10 working days. After validation is complete, prepare and transmit a Disposal Shipment Confirmation through DAAS to DRMS. Centrally Managed Equipment (CME) Information

During the past weeks a few questions pertaining to CME assets were raised throughout the Medical Logistics community. We have addressed these issues and would like to pass on pertinent information to all.

1. Why did CME item Master Records change back to using the actual Routing Identifier Code (RID) on the AFMLO Master File?

Since the last AFMLO Record Revision (ARR) approximately 2-3 years ago, the RID used for CME items has been the actual Source of Supply (SOS). The actual SOS is the Air Logistics Center loaded in FEDLOG and UDR. However, MEDLOG will not allow you to establish the master record for FID "C" items with the actual SOS RID and MEDLOG instructs users to enter a RID of "BSO" for CME items in the master record. Therefore, when notifying accounts to establish due-ins, AFMLO/FOC-O instructs each account to override the information in the master file with the appropriate codes for establishing their master records and due ins (see chart below).

(*-- Placing an "N" in the requisition indicator area will prevent MEDLOG from generating a requisition "AOA" image.)

2. How can a CME item be issued from WRM?

MEDLOG will not allow CME items to be issued from WRM. We recommend preparing DD Form 1348-1 and processing the GLT (Gains/Losses) transaction with action type MDL (DECAP/RECLASS MDSF ASSET) to drop the items. This will ensure proper accountability for the deployed asset.

3. What transaction should be processed for gaining of pallets and nets received from the War Reserve Materiel Officer/Noncommissioned Officer?

Preparing DD Form 1348-1 and processing the GLT (Gains/Losses) transaction with action type MDG (CAP/RECLASS MDSF ASSET) to gain items is recommended. This transaction is preferred over "Found on Base" to ensure proper accountability and capitalization of the CME asset.

Payment of Prime Vendor Invoices

DSCP has experienced a noticeable increase in interest payments because of delinquent Prime Vendor (PV) invoice payments. Interest is normally accrued on PV invoices not paid by DSCP within the required 15-day time period (30 days for OCONUS). Therefore, in order to minimize interest paid due to delinquent invoice payments, it is imperative medical facilities make every effort to process summary PV receipts in a timely manner.

Timely payment usually means an accurate receipt of PND data at DSCP. Always process a PND after all items on the call are received. The only reason not to process a PND is when the order is incomplete or incorrect. Whenever there is a discrepancy in shipment, contact the PV. If

the problem cannot be resolved by the next business day, contact the PV contract invoice facilitator at DSCP. Never change the original order without first coordinating those changes with the PV. If additional items are added to the call, ensure the correct purchase order and call number are input. If the order is placed offline, an individual folder should be set up to track PV receipts. Remember to review the PV Trouble List daily as no entries should be more than three days old. Any PNDs not completed should be resolved. Under no circumstances should DSCP be allowed to establish a phantom document number for billing purposes as it creates havoc on the accounting side of the house, even though the problem for DSCP to pay the PV may have cleared up.

Usually, the medical facility will process a PND within two or three days after receiving the delivered material from the PV. When the data submitted matches the invoice, payment is automatically processed through the Standard Automated Medical Materiel System (SAMMS), and the PV is paid by an electronic funds transfer on the 15th or 30th day. However, if the appropriate match is not made because the PND either is missing or is incorrect, payment will not occur. Manual intervention is required to research the problem and process the invoice for payment. This is where it becomes extremely important to provide information requested by the DSCP invoice facilitator so those invoices can be processed for payment. In fact, communication between the DSCP, PV, and the customer is critical to resolving any problem invoice.

DMLSS Trouble Tickets On-Line Submission

DMLSS trouble tickets can now be submitted on-line by Systems Administrators. This feature is accessible through the Tri-Service Medical Systems Support Center's (TMSSC) web site. Two user accounts for web ticket submissions are required. First time users will have to complete a simple on-line form to gain access to the web site (TMSSC InfoNet). Once access is obtained to the InfoNet, application must be made for a Remedy user account. Access is given to those requestors who are properly appointed DMLSS Systems Administrators.

Current Status of Decentralized Blanket Purchase Agreements (DBPAs)

Pages 1 through 82 of Attachment 3 contain the quarterly updated list of DBPAs. Pages 83 through 86 contain an alphabetical cross reference for the current DBPAs, and pages 87 through 90 provide a category reference. A Routing Identifier Codes (RIC) are included on pages 91 through 93. The DBPA Program includes DBPAs negotiated by DSCP, the Veterans Affairs, National Acquisition Center, and the AFMLO VA Special Services.

DBPA Vendors Must Certify Information in CCR Database Annually

Do you have invoices not being paid because the DBPA vendor is no longer enrolled in the Central Contractor Registration (CCR) database? The CCR is a single database of business information from contractors wanting to do business with the Department of Defense. Contractors must be registered in the CCR in order to do business with the government. They are required to provide information in the CCR only once, update the information anytime it changes, and certify its validity annually. If certification is not done annually, the CCR database will read "Status: Expired (date of expiration); Registration Inactive." DFAS must notify the vendor directly if the vendor's registration is expired or the vendor is not registered. Until the vendor is registered, DFAS cannot process the invoice. Should DFAS contact your facility about a DBPA vendor not registered in the CCR, refer them to AFMLO/FOM-P, Ms. Charlotte Christian, DSN 343-4164.
