Allowance Standard (AS) Updates

Attachment 4 contains AS updates. Changes are the result of cataloging actions to replace

Acquisition Advice Code “V” and “Y” NSNs and changes generated by the OPR. These changes are provided to update your WRM records. Remember to establish prime-sub relationships when applicable. Use the information in the “Add” and “Replaced” portion of the change document to determine the need for prime-sub relationships. If an NSN is replaced and there are on-hand balances, a prime-sub relationship should be established. Adjust WRM levels on NSNs listed as “Add” or “Delete.” If you have any questions or concerns, contact the appropriate AS manager. A list of the AS managers and the current version of each AS is available on the AFMLO web site at: <https://afml.ft-detrick.af.mil/afmlo/index.htm> located under Medical Readiness. Only minor changes are contained in this attachment and no SORTS reporting option is required. Any SORTS reporting option required as a result of a major AS change will be provided in the Transition Plan coordinated between the Pilot Unit, MEFPK, and HQ USAF/SGXR. Additionally, you may sign up on our AS Changes List Server to receive real-time notification of changes to AS that you maintain at your account. Medical/Surgical Prime Vendor (PV) **Generation II Transition**

The worldwide Medical/Surgical Prime Vendor (PV) Generation II transition began on 20 Oct 00. As of 1 Dec 00, Fairchild, McChord, and Langley have transitioned to Allegiance and the requirement for a minimum 90 percent PV fill rate on customer orders is not being met. The contracting officer at DSCP has notified Allegiance of this problem and an official response is pending. Medical Logistics is encouraged to establish and maintain good communication with the incoming PV in fostering a successful partnership. Please remember that under the Generation II PV contracts, orders for non-usage items will not be included in PV fill rate computations. It is important to accomplish frequent reviews of usage data to help the PV maximize fill rates. We recommend transitioning logistics activities request status on the availability of submitted usage items from the new PV prior to the transition date. As your base goes on line, monitor performance closely and report any problems that cannot be locally resolved promptly to AFMLO/FOM-P, Capt Ortiz, DSN 343-4168. Alternate Commercial Product Ordering Program (ACPOP) Items in Medical/Surgical Prime Vendor (PV)

DSCP has announced an expansion of the existing Medical/Surgical PV contract to include "NON-DAPA" items. The term "NON-DAPA" has been changed for contractual reasons to "Alternate Commercial Product Ordering Program" (ACPOP). Selecting Officials who have yet to announce a selection are permitted to consider a PV's agreement to ACPOP when making a selection. Regional Logistics Chiefs will be notified when this provision is activated in their respective regions.

The following Routing Identifier Codes (RID) have been assigned for use in MEDLOG and DMLSS:

Remember, only usage items will be included in the computation of PV order fill rates. ACPOP items will not be in the UDR and the DMLSS catalog will reflect the last price paid. Conversion of Distribution and Pricing Agreements (DAPA) to Federal Supply Schedule (FSS) Pricing

The Defense Supply Center Philadelphia (DSCP) is in the process of transitioning Pharmaceutical Prime Vendor (PV) Distribution and Pricing Agreements (DAPAs) to Federal Supply Schedules (FSS) for all pharmaceuticals covered by a FSS. Presently, there are 17,000 DAPA items that will be transitioned to FSS on 1 Jan 01. All of these FSS contracts are undergoing Public Law reviews, which may result in price modifications. As reviews are completed and awards are made, any price modifications will be reflected in the Pharmaceutical PV pricing catalog. Finalization of price changes stemming from the Public Law reviews are not anticipated before 15 Dec 00.

DSCP is working in conjunction with the VA to negotiate better prices for all federal agencies. Price changes resulting from these negotiations will be made on 1 Jan each year. To ensure prices are reasonable, DSCP will conduct an analysis of price changes when contracts are finalized. Electronic Catalog (ECAT) Program

Electronic Catalog (ECAT) is a web-based ordering system developed by DSCP. Its primary purpose is to provide the capability to electronically browse, compare, and order a wide range of commercial items via the web. The current commodities included in ECAT are laboratory, optical, dental, and medical equipment. ECAT can be accessed at www.medweb.dscp.dla.mil/ecat.html. You will need a login-ID and password before access is granted. Contact the ECAT Help Desk for this information at 800-290-8201, 800-441-1837, Extension 737-2443, or ecathelp@dscp.dla.mil. Once you have searched and found the product in ECAT, order it through MEDLOG.

Medical Logistics personnel are encouraged to use ECAT as an alternative to the IMPAC and DBPAs. ECAT has recently released a feature to allow direct interface with MEDLOG using MILSTRIP/MILBILLS, and will eliminate the

use of credit cards subsequently reducing reconciliation workload. Another benefit is that ECAT lists Total Delivered Prices. ECAT contracts are pre-priced Indefinite Delivery/Indefinite Quantity contracts that include transportation, surcharges, etc. Procedures to set up MEDLOG can be found at <http://www.ssg.gunter.af.mil/medsys/medlog/release/ecat/ecatinst.htm>. You can also contact Gunter AFB, DSN 596-4213, for additional information. To help facilitate the switch from DBPAs/IMPAC to ECAT, HQ AFMSA can help identify which items you are currently purchasing that may be available in ECAT. Extract a REP file into a MS Excel file that includes the stock numbers and part numbers of your Laboratory, Radiology and Dental items and forward the file to Maj Bauman at Kyle.Bauman@USAFSG.Brooks.af.mil, or contact him at DSN 240-3963, 210-536-3963.

Routing Identifiers (RIDs) are assigned locally by Medical Logistics using EC_. Position three of the RID can be alpha or numeric. As a suggestion, you may want to use ECL for laboratory, ECO for optical, ECD for dental, and ECE for equipment. Currently there are four commodity groups in ECAT, but DSCP is looking at other products to include in the ECAT platform.
